Structural Funds Review (I)

- Explore and analyze relevant:
 - Policies, Operational Programmes and current processes of the use of SF for health equity within your region
- Identify concrete examples
 - Opportunities and barriers
- Review and evaluate the use and knowledge of SF within your region



Structural Funds Review (II)

- Support the (National) partner in:
 - Conducting (online) questionnaires
 - Conducting key informant interviews
 - Produce report on SF
- Contribute to production of recommendations on:
“how the 2014-2020 programme could better enable action on the determinants of health inequalities”



Timeline (I)

- **March 2012: 2nd Regional meeting**
 - Structural Funds review work introduced
 - Online questionnaire discussed and agreed
 - Interview frameworks discussed and agreed



Timeline (II)

- **March - September 2012**
 - Review the use and knowledge of Structural Funds within your region
 - Support national partner: Conduct online questionnaires, Identify key informants, carry out interviews, production of a report on Structural Funds
 - Give feedback on the draft overall Report on how Structural Funds can be (better) used to address health inequalities

- **October 2012: 3rd regional meeting**
 - Outcomes of the (online) questionnaires and interviews will be presented
 - Discuss draft overall Review on how Structural Funds can be used to address health inequalities.
